

TAHOE GLYPHOSATE SPRAY ALERT



Spraying of the controversial synthetic herbicide glyphosate is happening at record levels in California's public forests, and the Forest Service has said that its large-scale use in Tahoe forests could begin in less than two years.

Glyphosate is classified as a probable human carcinogen by the World Health Organization, and a key safety study cited by the Forest Service in support of glyphosate use was retracted last year. Yet the Forest Service plans to proceed anyway.
